ORDINANCE NO. \_\_\_\_\_, 1981 Series

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING PERIODIC REPORTS OF PURCHASES BY PAWNBROKERS-TO INCLUDE PERSONS ENGAGED IN THE PURCHASE OF GOLD, SILVER OR OTHER PRECIOUS METALS OR JEWELRY

BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FRANKLIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT,

An Ordinance to read as follows:

(a) "Pawnbroker" is any person, firm or corporation whose occupation is or includes the taking and receiving by way of pledge, pawn or exchange of any goods, wares or any kind of merchandise as security for payment of money or any person engaged in the purchase of gold, silver or other precious metals or jewelry.


(b) Each pawnbroker operating in Franklin County shall keep a record of all purchases made by him wherein shall be stated, as to each item purchased, the name and address of the seller, physical description including height, weight, color of hair and eyes of the seller. The purchaser must require positive means of identification through documentation provided by the seller. The type of identification must be described and state the identification number, or two major credit cards. Social Security cards will not be accepted as a means of identification. This record shall also contain a description of the item, and the price paid therefor, and the signature of the Frankfort police department and shall be filed with the police department not later than five(5) days following the fifteenth and the last day of each calendar month.

(c) Any person, firm or corporation violating any provision of this section shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall, for each offense, be fined not less than One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) nor more than Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00).
