ORDINANCE #16-2004

AN ORDINANCE TO PERMIT TEMPORARY OFF-SITE SALE OR DISPLAY EVENTS ("TENT SALES") OF MOTOR VEHICLES BY DEALER IN FRANKLIN COUNTY (PURSUANT TO KRS 190.030)

WHEREAS, the Kentucky Legislature has enacted House Bill 219 prohibiting temporary off-site sale of display events ("tent sales") absent certain conditions; and

WHEREAS, Franklin County Fiscal Court desires to facilitate the motor vehicle dealers' ability to continue temporary off-site motor vehicle sales of display events ("tent sales"),

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE FISCAL COURT OF THE COUNTY OF FRANKLIN, COMMONWEALTH OF KENTUCKY, that motor vehicle dealers may conduct temporary off-site sales or display events ("tent") provided all other licensing or permitting requirements are met.

INTRODUCED AND G IVEN FIRST READING IN SUMMARY at a duly convened meeting of the Fiscal Court of Franklin County, Kentucky, held on the 1st of August 2004.

This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force when passed, published and recorded according to law.
