

ORDINANCE NO. 10, 2003 SERIES

AN ORDINANCE RELATING TO THE FRANKLIN COUNTY SOIL CONSERVATION DISTRICT AND THE LEVY OF A MILLAGE TAX ON ALL REAL PROPERTY WITHIN FRANKLIN COUNTY, KENTUCKY.

Whereas, The Franklin County Soil Conservation District is a subdivision of state government and has been organized for the special purpose to assist landowners and land users in solving soil and water resource problems; setting priorities for conservation work to be accomplished; coordinating the federal, state, and local resources needed to accomplish this work and provide leadership at the local level and means for interested local citizens to work together to achieve desired results and

Whereas, KRS 262.200, Kentucky's Conservation District Law provides a means for districts to finance their programs through Fiscal Courts; and

Whereas, The County recognizes that county general funds no longer meet the financial needs of the District and


- (1) KRS 262.200 (4) allows the levy of a millage tax on all real property within the boundaries of the county.
- (2) The District has provided an annual plan of work.

Now therefore be it ordained by the Fiscal Court, County of Franklin, Commonwealth of Kentucky that:

A millage tax is hereby levied on all real property within the boundaries of Franklin County pursuant to KRS 132.017 and shall become effective on the date of the second reading and adoption.

Introduced, seconded and given first reading approval at a duly convened meeting of the Fiscal Court of Franklin County Kentucky held on the 6 day of June, 2003.

Given second reading and adopted at a duly convened meeting of the Fiscal Court of Franklin County, Kentucky, held on the 19 day of June, 2003, and of record in Fiscal Court Order Book 19 page 211.
