## FRANKLIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT MARCH 7, 2014 9:00 A.M. WORK SESSION/COURT

Franklin County Fiscal Court met on Friday, March 7, 2014 in the Fiscal Court Room at 321 West Main Street, Frankfort, KY. The meeting was called to order at 10:17 a.m. with Judge Ted Collins presiding. The following members of Fiscal Court were present: Squire Jill Robinson, Squire Phillip Kring, Squire Don Sturgeon, Squire Larry B. Perkins, Squire Huston Wells and Squire Lambert Moore. County Attorney Rick Sparks was in attendance.
