## TEMPORARY PERMANENT SERVICE AGREEMENT

This office shall authorize temporary electrical service for the project located at

For ninety (90) days to aid in completing construction, subject to the following conditions.

1. If a Certificate of Occupancy has not been issued within ninety (90) days, an additional agreement must be filed with this office.

- 2. The building service has been installed and inspected.
- 3. The electrical service shall be for construction purpose only.
- 4. The building shall not be occupied, in whole or in part, until a Certificate of Occupancy has been issued.
- 5. A temporary service requires an inspection through its service panel. This office has not inspected beyond the service and panel and makes no finding as to its condition.
- 6. Permanent service may be issued only after a satisfactory final electrical inspection by the Franklin County Electrical Inspector has been completed.

If this agreement and/or any of the six (6) conditions listed herein are violated by the signee, the signee agrees and understands that the meter may be pulled and the service disconnected.

In addition, the signee also understands that he/she shall not be permitted to request a Temporary Permanent Electrical Service on any project for which the signee is listed as owner and/or contractor for ninety (90) days from the date of violation.

If the owner and/or contractor violates an agreement for a Temporary Permanent Electrical Service on any project for which the signee is listed as owner and/or contractor a second time, this privilege shall be suspended for one (1) calendar year from the date of violation.

If the owner and/or contractor violates a Temporary Permanent Electrical Service on any project for which the signee is listed as owner and/or contractor a third time, this privilege shall be suspended for two (2) calendar years from the date of violation.
