FRANKLIN COUNTY MARCH 2021 FLOOD GRANT APPLICATION

Applications can be submitted via the drop box in front of 321 W Main Street or emailed to floodgrants@franklincounty.ky.gov. Deadline for submission is 4:30PM May 7, 2021.

In order for your expenses incurred to be considered eligible for reimbursement, you must:

- Have a home or business located within the areas affected by the March 2021 flood event.
- Not have been reimbursed for the same expenses by any other payment program, loan, or grant.
- Turn in your receipts for any municipal solid waste disposed of as a result of the flooding.
 - *Municipal solid waste* is defined as “household solid waste and commercial solid waste” in KRS 224.01-010(31).
 - Household solid waste means garbage and trash generated by single and multiple family residences, hotels, motels, bunkhouses, ranger stations, crew quarters, and recreational areas.
 - Commercial solid waste means solid waste generated by stores, offices, restaurants, warehouses, and other service and nonmanufacturing activities.
 - Driftwood, limbs, brush, etc. are NOT municipal solid waste and disposal of those items cannot be covered through this grant.
- Applicant name and/or address should correspond with information on the receipts presented for reimbursement.
