Lock installation should take about two weeks. Showers are being installed next week with installation of 8 pods with 2 showers in each pod.

Fencing of the Jail: \$128,000 has been quoted. State Homeland Security Grant will open in the spring that will assist with the overall cost.

Cameras: Placement is being discussed. 21 cameras are currently in operation.

Other Business: Mental Health Services at the jail were discussed and a position at the jail to assist inmates with re-entry and everyday needs.
