Meeting Summary/Narrative:

E-911 Board: Draft language of an Interlocal Cooperation Agreement of 911 Services was reviewed that was drafted by the City of Frankfort. Minor edits were made that will be sent back to the City of Frankfort for adoption with a final document to be reviewed by May 10, 2024.

FCFD Road Access discussion: Several areas in the county were discussed where it is difficult for fire apparatus and emergency vehicles to gain access to those in need. Some of the areas discussed were Industrial Park 3 (Duncan Road), Farmdale, Bentwoods and Maples subdivision.

Active Shooter Training: City of Frankfort offered active shooter training to city and county employees on April 30th – May 2nd. Deputy Dwayne Depp of the Franklin County Sheriff's office discussed offering active shooter training and a plan for each county office building in the upcoming weeks. Ashley Case, Human Resources Director will be coordinating an active shooter training for each office/building.

Other Business: Squire Sebastian inquired on Fire Gates/Quadrants and the response from FCFD and other surrounding emergency services in the case of an extreme incident. Chief Brewer explained their policies and procedures that are in place and the appropriate HAZMAT response if needed, etc.

A grant for flashing lights on homes when there is an emergency was also discussed utilizing GIS mapping.

Recommendations:

Interlocal Cooperation Agreement for the E-911 Board will be reviewed by May 10, 2024.

Active Shooter Training/Plan for each county office will be scheduled in the upcoming weeks.
