

**FRANKLIN COUNTY FISCAL COURT
PUBLIC HEARING
OCTOBER 15, 2025, 4:30 P.M.**

Franklin County Fiscal Court held a public hearing on Wednesday, October 15 2025, in person for the purpose of obtaining citizen's comments from the public regarding the proposed issuance by the County of an aggregate principal amount not to exceed \$1,800,000 of its tax-exempt Dedicated Tax Revenue and Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2025 (Save the Grand Theatre Project) (the “Bonds”), for the purpose of (i) financing, for the benefit of Save the Grand Theatre, Inc., a Kentucky nonprofit corporation and an organization qualified under Section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as amended (the “Corporation”), the cost of renovating, improving and equipping the Grand Theatre, a 428-seat theatre and art gallery located at 308 St. Clair Street in Frankfort, Kentucky, (ii) refunding a portion of the County’s outstanding Dedicated Tax Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2015 (Save the Grand Theatre Project), and (iii) paying a portion of the costs of issuance for the Bonds.

The primary location of the public hearing was held at 321 West Main Street. The following members of the Fiscal Court were present: Squire Sherry Sebastian, Squire JW Blackburn, Squire Mike Harrod, Squire Richard Tanner, Squire Eric Whisman, and Judge Michael Mueller. Squire Kelly Dycus was absent. County Attorney Max Comley was in attendance.

The meeting was called to order at 4:34 p.m.

Motion by Squire Sebastian, seconded by Squire Blackburn, for authorization to adjourn. Voting in favor of the motion were Squires Sebastian, Blackburn, Harrod, Tanner, Whisman, and Judge Mueller. Motion passed. (Meeting adjourned at 4:39 p.m.)
